Teen Manga & Anime Group

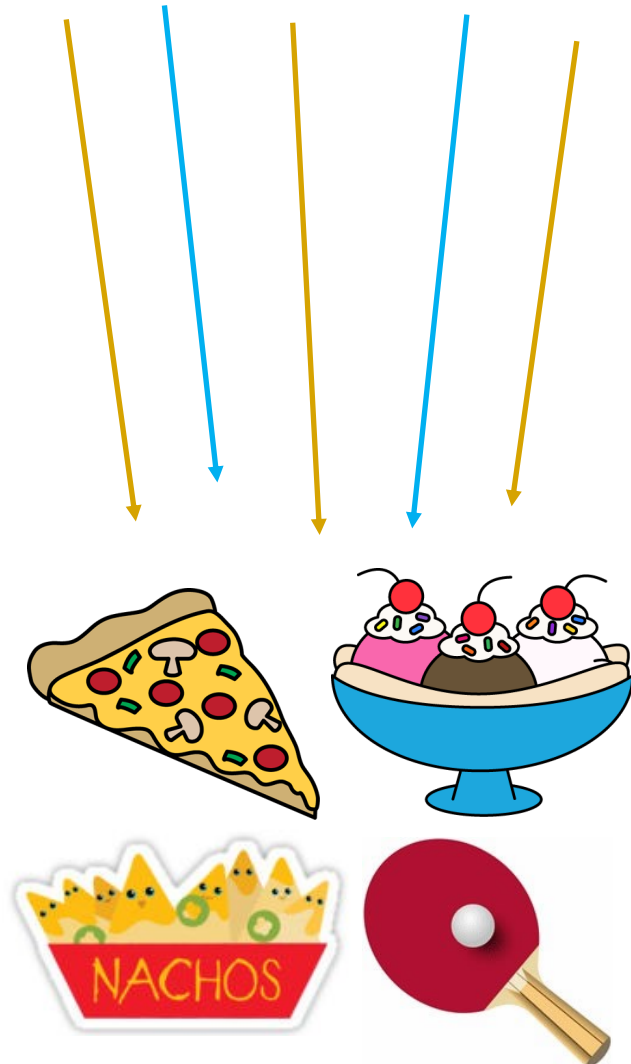

Since the library will be closed, we'll have it all to ourselves, so bring your friends! No registration required –just show up!

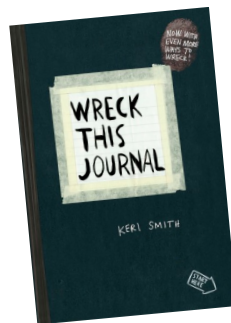
TEEN VOLUNTEER CREW
